Update on the number of positive cases in Greene County

Snow Hill, NC – On Friday, June 12th, the Greene County Department of Public Health reported 10 new lab-confirmed COVID-19 positive cases. The Health Department has since learned that two of those cases belong to another county and that information has been transferred to that county (bringing our total to 113 cases).

On Saturday, June 13th, the Greene County Department of Public Health received notification of 2 new lab-confirmed COVID-19 positive cases and on Sunday, June 14th, we received notification of 4 new lab-confirmed COVID-19 positive cases. Today, our local health department has received notification of 2 new lab-confirmed COVID-19 positive cases. That brings our total number of cases to 121.

Out of the 121 lab-confirmed positive cases to date, 57 of the individuals have recovered, are doing well, and are out of isolation. Greene County currently has 59 active cases and the Health Department is monitoring those individuals. There are three other individuals currently hospitalized. Greene County has had two deaths.
