Update on the number of COVID-19 cases in Greene County

Snow Hill, NC – Today, the Greene County Department of Public Health received notification of 5 new lab-confirmed COVID-19 positive cases.

During our case investigation work today, the Health Department learned that one of the positive cases that we reported yesterday belongs to another county and that information has been transferred to that county. That brings our total number of cases to 190.

Out of the 190 lab-confirmed positive cases to date, 145 of the individuals have recovered, are doing well, and are out of isolation. Greene County currently has 42 active cases and the Health Department is monitoring those individuals. Currently, there are no individuals hospitalized. Greene County has had three deaths.
