Update on the number of COVID-19 cases in Greene County

Snow Hill, NC – The Greene County Department of Public Health has received notification of 15 new lab-confirmed positive COVID-19 cases over the weekend. That brings our total number of cases to 309.

Out of the 309 lab-confirmed positive cases to date, 258 of the individuals have recovered, are doing well, and are out of isolation. Greene County currently has 45 active cases and the Health Department is monitoring those individuals. Currently, there are three individuals hospitalized. Greene County has had three deaths.

- 17,918,582 confirmed cases globally; 686,703 deaths
- United States: 4,649,102 confirmed cases; 154,471 deaths
- NC has confirmed 126,532 cases of COVID-19 across all 100 counties*
 - Deaths = 1,982*
 - Completed Tests = 1,837,410*
 - Currently Hospitalized = 1,057*
