Update on the number of COVID-19 cases in Greene County

Snow Hill, NC – Today, the Greene County Department of Public Health received notification of 7 new lab-confirmed positive COVID-19 cases. That brings our total number of cases to 346.

Out of the 346 lab-confirmed positive cases to date, 318 of the individuals have recovered, are doing well, and are out of isolation. Greene County currently has 25 active cases; the Health Department is monitoring 19 of those individuals and the other six individuals are currently hospitalized. Greene County has had three deaths.

- 21,756,357 confirmed cases globally; 771,635 deaths
- United States: 5,422,242 confirmed cases; 169,870 deaths
- NC has confirmed 146,779 cases of COVID-19 across all 100 counties*
 - Deaths = 2,396*
 - Completed Tests = 1,951,120*
 - Currently Hospitalized = 1,026*
