

POLLING PLACE BUFFER ZONES
2019 CONGRESSIONAL PRIMARY

The following is a list of Greene County polling places and a description of each buffer zone. Buffer zones are designated in accordance with G.S. 163A-1134. The County Board of Elections shall, where practical, set the limit at 50 feet from the door of entrance to the voting place, measured when that door is closed, but in no event shall it set the limit at more than 50 feet or less than 25 feet.

The poll workers will mark buffer zones on Election Day with signs designating no electioneering beyond this point.

- Arba: Arba Fire Station, 2001 Jesse Hill Rd, Snow Hill, NC
Electioneering is allowed 50 feet from the front door.
- Bear Garden: Victory and Dominion World Outreach Center (Family Life Center) 1438 Hwy 258 N, Snow Hill, NC
Electioneering is allowed 50 feet from the front door to the fellowship hall.
- Bull Head: Bull Head Fire Station, 7553 Hwy 58 N, Stantonsburg, NC
Electioneering is allowed 50 feet from the side door of the station.
- Castoria: Castoria Fire Station, 5118 Hwy 91, Snow Hill, NC
Electioneering is allowed 50 feet from the side door of the station.
- Hookerton: Hookerton Fire Station, 404 E Main St, Hookerton, NC
Electioneering is allowed 50 feet from the side door of the building.
- Maury: Maury Fire Station, 3659 Hwy 903 N, Snow Hill, NC
Electioneering is allowed 50 feet from the back door of the building.
- Shine: Shine Fire Station, 84 Shine Rd, Snow Hill, NC
Electioneering is allowed 50 feet from the side door of the station.
- Snow Hill #1: Snow Hill Fire Station, 201 Carolina Drive, Snow Hill, NC
Electioneering is allowed 50 feet from the door of the meeting room.
- Sugg: Rainbow Church Recreation Center, 2507 Hwy 58 S, Snow Hill, NC
Electioneering is allowed 50 feet from the front door of the building.
- Walstonburg: Walstonburg Fire Station, 409 N Wilson St, Walstonburg, NC
Electioneering is allowed 50 feet from the front door of the station.

Poll workers will mark buffer zones during One-Stop Voting with signs designating no electioneering beyond this point.

- Board of Elections Office: 110 SE First Street, Snow Hill, NC
Electioneering is allowed 50 feet from each side door of the building.
