

Family Caregiver Support Programs in Greene County

The Family Caregiver Support Program funds a range of supports that assist family and informal caregivers to care for their loved ones at home. Family Caregiver Support Programs are funded under the Older American's Act.

Eligible Program Participants

The following specific populations of family caregivers are eligible to receive services:

- Adult family members or other informal caregivers age 18 and older providing care to individuals 60 Years of age and older;
- Adult family members or other informal caregivers age 18 and older providing care to individuals of any age with Alzheimer's Disease and related disorders
- The Caregiver receiving Respite or Supplemental services must be taking care of someone who is frail, which means: 1) The person receiving care is unable to perform at least 2 activities of daily living with substantial human assistance, including verbal reminding, physical cueing, or supervision or 2) Due to a cognitive or other mental impairment, requires substantial supervision because the individual behaves in a manner that poses a serious health or safety hazard to the individual or to another individual.

 - Incontinence Supplies as available
 - Home Safety Devices-Door Alarms
 - Home Delivered Meals & Liquid Nutritional Supplements
 - Electronic Companion Comfort Pets for persons with Dementia
